G.S.R. 317.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment class III posts in the Trade Marks Registry, namely:—

1. Short Title.—These rules may be called the Trade Marks Registry (Class III Recruitment Rules, 1962.
2. Application.—These rules shall apply to Class III posts in the Trade Marks Registry as specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed hereto.
3. Number, Classification and scale of pay.—The number of posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached to them shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 12 of the Schedule aforesaid:

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders of the Government of India issued from time to time.

5. Disqualification.—No person, who has more than one wife living or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life-time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment service; and

no woman, whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to service.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
