**G.S.R. 328.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Office of the Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trade Marks, (Group 'C') Recruitment Rules 1962, in so far as they relate to the posts of Assistant Examiner of Trade Marks, Assistant Superintendent, Cashier, Personal Assistant to Joint Registrar, Photography Assistant, Upper Division Clerk, Stenographer, Librarian and Lower Division Clerk (including Assistant Cashier-cum-Typist, Dispatcher and Typists), the Ministry of Industry (Department of Industrial Development) (Office of the Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trade Marks, Bombay) Staff Car Driver Recruitment Rules, 1987, the office of the Controller General of Patent, Designs and Trade Marks Junior Hindi Translator Recruitment Rules, 1994, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'C' (Non-Gazetted) posts in the Trade Marks and Geographical Indications Registry in the Office of the Controller General of Patents, Designs, Trade Marks and Geographical Indications, under Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, namely:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Trade Marks and Geographical Indications Registry Group 'C' (Non-Gazetted) Recruitment Rules, 2005.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.**—The number of post, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.**—The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.**—No person,—

(i) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person, having a spouse living; or

(ii) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so, doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax.**—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

सा.का.नि. 329.—राष्ट्रपति, संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 के परन्तुक द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए और महानियंत्रक कार्यालय, पेटेंट, डिजाइन और व्यापार चिह्न (वर्ग 4 पद) भर्ती नियम, 1975 को जहां तक उनका संबंध अभिलेखा पाल, गैस्टेटर प्रचालक, दफ्तरी, चपरासी, फराश और चौकीदार के पदों से है और उन बावों के सिवाय अधिक्रांत करते हुए, जिन्हें ऐसे अधिक्रमण से पहले किया गया है या करने का लोप किया गया है, वाणिज्य और उद्योग मंत्रालय, औद्योगिक नीति और संवर्धन विभाग के अधीन महानियंत्रक कार्यालय, पेटेंट, डिजाइन और व्यापार चिह्न में, व्यापार चिह्न और भौगोलिक उपदर्शन रजिस्ट्री में समूह 'घ' पदों पर भर्ती की पद्धति का विनियमन करने के लिए निम्नलिखित नियम बनाते हैं, अर्थात् :—

1. संक्षिप्त नाम और प्रारम्भ.—(1) इन नियमों का संक्षिप्त नाम व्यापार चिह्न और भौगोलिक उपदर्शन रजिस्ट्री समूह 'घ' (अराजपत्रित) भर्ती नियम, 2005 है।

(2) ये राजपत्र में प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।

2. पद संख्या, वर्गीकरण और वेतनमान.— उक्त पदों की संख्या, उनका वर्गीकरण और उनके वेतनमान वे होंगे, जो इन नियमों से उपाबद्ध अनुसूची के स्तंभ 2 से स्तंभ 4 में विनिर्दिष्ट हैं।

3. भर्ती की पद्धति, आयु-सीमा अर्हताएं आदि.— उक्त पदों पर भर्ती की पद्धति, आयु-सीमा, अर्हताएं और उनसे संबंधित अन्य बातें वे होंगी जो उक्त अनुसूची के स्तंभ 5 से स्तंभ 14 में विनिर्दिष्ट हैं।

4. निरर्हता.— वह व्यक्ति,—

(क) जिसने ऐसे व्यक्ति से जिसका पति या जिसकी पत्नी जीवित है, विवाह किया है, या

(ख) जिसने अपने पति या अपनी पत्नी के जीवित रहते हुए किसी व्यक्ति से विवाह किया है,

उक्त पद पर नियुक्ति का पात्र नहीं होगा :

परन्तु यदि केन्द्रीय सरकार का यह समाधान हो जाता है कि ऐसा विवाह, ऐसे व्यक्ति और विवाह के अन्य पक्षकार को लागू स्वीय विधि के अधीन अनुज्ञेय है और ऐसा करने के लिए अन्य आधार हैं तो वह किसी व्यक्ति को इस नियम के प्रवर्तन से छूट दे सकेगी।

5. शिथिल करने की शक्ति.— जहां केन्द्रीय सरकार की यह राय है कि ऐसा करना आवश्यक या समीचीन है, वहां वह उसके लिए जो कारण हैं उन्हें लेखबद्ध करके इन नियमों के किसी उपबंध को किसी वर्ग या प्रवर्ग के व्यक्तियों की बाबत, आदेश द्वारा शिथिल कर सकेगी।

6. व्यावृत्ति.— इन नियमों की कोई बात, ऐसे आरक्षण, आयु-सीमा में छूट और अन्य रियायतों पर प्रभाव नहीं डालेगी, जिनका केन्द्रीय सरकार द्वारा इस संबंध में समय-समय पर निकाले गए आदेशों के अनुसार अनुसूचित जातियों, अनुसूचित जनजातियों, अन्य पिछड़े वर्गों भूतपूर्व मैनों और अन्य विशेष प्रवर्ग के व्यक्तियों के लिए उपबंध करना अपेक्षित है।
